- 2. Work may not start until a permit has been issued and a permit is not issued until approval is given and the permit is purchased. Work done prior to approval will cause the permit fees to double and could result in a stop work order, possible removal of any construction, and possible citation.
- 3. Inspections are to be requested as needed during the work. <u>A final inspection must be done</u>, and a Certificate of Occupancy issued before a building or structure is occupied. Failure to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy prior to occupying a building or structure could result in citation and/or fines.
- 4. You are responsible for ensuring that you meet all deed restriction or HOA requirements prior to obtaining a permit. The City does not regulate deed restriction or HOA requirements.
