ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO CITY, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-07, ZONING ORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF THE CITY ZONING MAP TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Texas, authority is conferred upon the City of Colorado City to enact a zoning ordinance and to provide for its administration, enforcement, and amendment;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Colorado City did on April 13, 2010 by Ordinance No. 2010-07 adopt the Zoning Ordinance of the City for the health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the City;

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to the provisions of the State Statutes, has appointed a Planning and Zoning Commission to recommend the boundaries of the various original districts and appropriate regulations to be enforced therein, as well as to make recommendations for amendment of the Zoning Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has given reasonable consideration to the amendments to the Zoning Ordinance contained herein, has held public hearings thereon, and has submitted its final report to the City Council;

WHEREAS, the City Council has given due public notice of hearings relating to the amendments to the Zoning Ordinance contained herein, and has held such public hearings as may be required;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the downtown core of the City has historic and cultural significance and that it is the intent of the City to encourage the revitalization of the downtown area by establishing the Mixed Use District (MX1); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the Multiple Use District (MX2), to promote further economic development and vitality in areas near the interstate highway and other connecting highway corridors and to make better use of land and existing structures in those areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO CITY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Amendment

The City Council of the City of Colorado City declares that Ordinance No. 2010-07, Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended as follows:

Amendment 1. Article I, Sec. 2-Definitions shall be amended by adding the following provision and renumbering the subsequent definitions in Section 2:

2-58 <u>Mixed-Use Building:</u> A building that contains at least one space devoted to allow nonresidential uses and at least one devoted to allow residential uses.

Amendment 2. Article I, Sec. 3-Zoning Districts shall be amended by adding two additional zoning districts to read as follows:

SEC. 3. ZONING DISTRICTS: The City of Colorado City, Mitchell County, Texas, is hereby divided into ten (10) zoning districts, as follows:

- **Amendment 3**. Article I, Sec. 3-Zoning Districts shall be further amended by adding definitions for the newly-created zoning districts to read as follows:
 - 2-10. <u>Mixed-Use Building:</u> A building that contains at least one space devoted to allow nonresidential uses and at least one devoted to allow residential uses.
- **Amendment 4**. Article I, Sec. 4-Zoning District Map shall be amended to read as follows:
- SEC. 4. ZONING DISTRICT MAP: The location and boundaries of the districts within the City shall be shown upon the official Zoning Map, as adopted by the City Council and as shall be amended from time to time by action of the City Council. The original of the Zoning District Map shall be filed in the office of the City Secretary. Said Zoning Map, together with all notations, references and other information shown thereon and all amendments thereto, shall be as much a part of the Zoning Ordinance as if fully set forth and described herein.
- Amendment 5. The City Council hereby authorizes the amendment of the Zoning District Map to change the zoning designation for the Main Street designated area described as all of Blocks 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 of the Original Town of Colorado City to Mixed Use District (MX1) and a designated area described as all of Blocks 2 and 3 of the Stinson Addition to the City of Colorado City to Multiple Use District (MX2). A revised Zoning District Map shall be prepared and adopted reflecting these changes.

- (1) Interior yard requirements may be waived in the case of townhouse developments; Interior side yard requirements may be waived for patio homes provided there is at least ten (10) feet between the structures.
- (2) A building may be erected to a height of eight (8) stories or one hundred (100) feet if set back from all required yard lines a distance of one (1) foot for each two (2) feet of additional height above forty-five (45) feet.

- (3) No rear yard required except that a rear yard of not less than fifteen (15) feet in depth shall be provided upon that portion of a lot abutting upon a residential district.
- (4) No side yard shall be required except that a side yard of not less than six (6) feet in width shall be provided on the side of a lot adjoining a residential district.
- (5) Buildings may exceed ten (10) stories or one hundred twenty-five (125) feet if set back one (1) foot for every two (2) feet of height above one hundred twenty-five (125) feet, but in no case shall the height of the building exceed the total of the street width on which it faces plus the depth of the front yard.
- (6) Whenever a building in a "LI" or "HI" District adjoins or abuts a residential district, such building shall not exceed three stories or forty-five (45) feet in height unless it is set back one (1) foot from the required side and rear yard lines for each foot of additional height above forty-five (45) feet.

SECTION 2: Conflict

In the event any provision passed and approved herein shall be discovered to be in conflict with any other provision of the Zoning Ordinance of the City, the provision contained herein shall apply until such time as further action is taken to by the Council to reconcile such conflict.

SECTION 3: Severability Clause

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Colorado City that any phrase, sentence, section, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remainder of this ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of the unconstitutional or invalid phrase, sentence, section or paragraph.

SECTION 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in the full force and effect as of the date of its passage.
