Cudahy, WI - On Wednesday, March 29, 2023, at 3:26 pm, the Cudahy Police and Fire Departments were dispatched to Ewald's Venus Ford, 2727 E. Layton Ave., for an employee involved in a suspected industrial accident.

The victim, identified as a 42 year old Johnson Creek man, was pronounced dead at the scene.

The Cudahy Police Department is being assisted by investigators from the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), and the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the victim was doing electrical work prior to being found unresponsive. A cause of death determination will be made by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's office.
