Cudahy, WI - On Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 03:14 hours, the Cudahy Police Department initiated the pursuit of a motor vehicle, on E. Layton Ave., in Cudahy. The initial reason for the pursuit was speeding, unsafe lane deviation, and improper display of registration. The pursuit lasted approximately 3.4 miles and the top speed reached approximately 100 mph. The suspect vehicle was last seen in South Milwaukee. Due to the dangerousness of the suspect's speeds and because the police officer lost sight of the vehicle, the supervisor monitoring the pursuit instructed the pursuing police officer to terminate the pursuit.

Approximately 40 minutes later, the South Milwaukee Police Department located the vehicle, which was involved in a single car crash, in near N. Chicago Avenue and Rawson Avenue. The driver, a 23 year old Milwaukee man, was found deceased. There were no other occupants inside the vehicle.

It was later discovered that the deceased suspect had a warrant for his arrest, issued by Probation and Parole.

The crash is being investigated by the South Milwaukee Police Department.
