


#### **HNWS CREWS BEGIN SERVICE LINE INVENTORY**

HNWS crews have been working throughout the water system to identify service line materials. You may have seen them working around the meter in your yard. This effort is related to the new U.S. Evironmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations for lead and copper in the water

distribution system.

To date, HNWS has found no lead services, nor any indication of lead fittings on either our service lines or the customer's service line downstream of the meter.



## **Sewer Side Chat**

HNWS recently added a new piece of equipment to its inventory that will help us maintain our sewer system. The vehicle was purchased by Municipal Engineering Services (MESI), a wholly-owned subsidiary of HNWS, and will be utilized by both entities.

Before the March Board Meeting, Staff gave a live demonstration to the HNWS Board of Directors and community members while explaining the importance of the equipment.

The Rapid View UTV is a self-contained camera system that enables us to access remote locations and gather CCTV footage and data of the underground sewer and stormwater drainage systems in those remote areas.

This information will help us in keeping our wastewater collection system operating in an efficient and safe manner.
