Structure Fire, 6020 Oakwood Dr, Lisle Ill 60532



At 7:02am on Thursday, December 12, 2024, the Lisle-Woodridge Fire District was notified, via a 911 call, of a structure fire at 6020 Oakwood Drive in Lisle.

The caller was directed to activate the fire alarm in the building to alert residents and begin evacuation.

A Structure Fire Response was immediately dispatched, sending four (4) engines, two (2) ladder trucks, two (2) medic units, and a Command Team to the scene.

The first unit arrived at 7:07am and reported smoke and fire from the roof. Initial report stated possible fire on the 5th floor. Fire was located on the roof, where crews were able to mitigate through extinguishment and overhaul.

The alarm was elevated at 7:20am and fire was under control at 7:57am. The box alarm was struck at 8:13am.

No injuries were reported to residents. One (1) minor firefighter injury was reported. Warming locations were made available by neighboring buildings and a warming bus was requested to the scene. American Red Cross was requested to the scene to assist residents after the fire.

Lisle-Woodridge units were assisted at the scene by responding units from Darien-Woodridge Fire District, Downers Grove Fire Department, Naperville Fire Department, Warrenville Fire District, Bolingbrook Fire Department, and Lombard Fire Department.
