Chair Fonzie Flowers called the meeting to order at 10:00am. In attendance were Chair Fonzie Flowers, Committee Members, David Jerosse, Captain Lemons, Alysa McLaughlin, Cat Redd, A.C. Rich, Jim Moss, Lila Hedlund, and Emily Hurd. New Member Michelle Faulkner and Deputy Clerk Ravi Boze-Adams were also in attendance. Members Aubrey Cooper and Nathan Page were absent.

The first item on the agenda was to approve the Minutes from the Regular Meeting held on January 13, 2023, as presented.

MOTION: TO APPROVE MINUTES FROM THE JANUARY 13, 2023 REGULAR MEETING

The motion was made by Member Hedlund, seconded by Member Redd, and passed unanimously, 9-0 (Moss entered the meeting after the vote).

The next item on the agenda was Old Business:

- A. DISCUSSION OF DRAFT LOGO DESIGN – SHAWN TERPACK – ARNETT MULDROW & ASSOCIATES Ltd.
 - i. Mr. Terpack was unable to attend.
 - ii. After a verbal survey, the Board decided on logo 6-B for the official logo, as seen in the current letterhead. The colors for 6-B will be used for unofficial use. Sponsorship logos were approved as presented. Mr. Terpack will be contacted with the decisions for a complete workup, which will be presented at the March 10th meeting.

B. DISCUSSION ON CELEBRATION ACTIVITIES AND DATES.

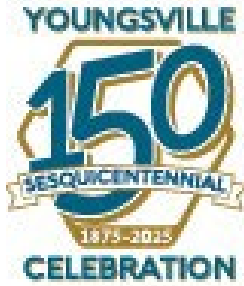
- i. Fundraising Events:



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1. Golf Tournament, yearly, with first one on June 9, 2023, rain date June 16, 2023
 2. 5-K Run on March 16, 2024 & March 15, 2025
 3. Souvenirs will be put on the market in late 2024, with distribution to start in 2025
 4. Silent Auction, with possible Casino Night in November 2023
 5. Cook Offs to start in 2023. Member Redd will speak with Buck at Bud's regarding profit margins and best operational practices. Potential venues considered are Luddy Park, Faith Baptist (no alcohol on premises) or the new ABC Property
- ii. Sponsorships:
1. Platinum- \$9,150 Gold- \$6,150 Silver- \$3,150 Bronze- \$1,500.
 2. Friends of Youngsville- includes in-kind and monetary donations \$150 and above, which donors will receive at least a t-shirt. An additional hat is in consideration for higher brackets.
 3. Excess funds will be used for future endowments like Shop with a Cop, Friends of the Parks, other civic organizations and/ or possibly a Town Arch that may cost upwards of \$50,000.
 4. Members were charged with bringing back suggestions for sponsorship package details.
- iii. Events:
1. Plant 150 Trees, with a picture of the tree and the planter and/or donors who contribute \$150 to the cause on the website.
 2. Food Drive at the Cookoffs with donations going to The Journey Ministry Pantry in Youngsville.
 3. Main Street Festival:
 - a. Saturday - May 17th – Rain Date May 31st
 - b. 9:00 am Vendors on Main Street
 - c. 9:30 am Morning Prayer at Mitchell Park
 - d. 10:00 am Parade with Decade Decorated Float Contest
 - e. 11:00 am Family Fun, Multiple Music Stations, Historic Tours, and more all between Luddy Park and Panic Point
 - f. Fireworks 7:30pm
 4. Environmental Component of a Zero Waste Initiative is being considered, such as no Styrofoam, recycling bins use, and composting of food waste at vendor trucks and restaurants.

The next item on the agenda was New Business. There were none.



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The next item on the agenda was Reports.

A. Subcommittees:

- a. Activities -McLaughlin stated March's Opening Day of Spring Baseball will kick-off activities. She also reiterated the June 2023-2025 Golf Tournaments.
- b. Fireworks – AC Rich noted that at least 800 ft of setback from structures will be required at fireworks venues. Luddy Park, Panic Point and Youngsville Elementary are being considered. He also noted a \$3,000 minimum price quote.
- c. Fundraising -nothing further
- d. Marketing - none
- e. Parade – Hurd wants floats entries to reflect a historic decade, with possible prize

The meeting adjourned at 11:32 am upon a motion made by Member Hedlund, seconded by Member Redd, and approved unanimously, 10-0.
